DRIVER EDUCATION-- SUMMER 2010

Parent/Student Information Sheet

Driver Education instruction will be offered to students who have transportation to and from KSD for their classes. The dorm will be closed. Students must obtain a Kansas Instructional Permit (IP) prior to enrollment. The course will consist of least 20 hours of classroom instruction and 8 hours driving and observation experience. All classes will be conducted in sign language. Successful completion of this course enables the student to obtain a Kansas Drivers License (16 ½ years old) or a Restricted License (15 years old).

DATES FOR DRIVER EDUCATION CLASS:

- **Monday, June 7th to Monday, June 21st** (In-class instruction and Driving daily)
- A classroom and driving lesson will begin at 8:00 A.M. (See KSD Driver Education Calendar)
- Depending on the number of enrollment driving lesson may be scheduled 8:00 A.M. to 12 P.M. from Tuesday, June 22 to Friday, June 25

LOCATION:

- Kansas School for the Deaf, Roberts Building #209, 450 East Park St., Olathe 66061

TRANSPORTATION TO SCHOOL:

- Students are responsible for getting to their Driver Education class (school).
- Dormitory room is not available.

AGE FOR PARTICIPANTS:

- A student must be at least fifteen (15) years of age before the first day of the course.
- If more students desire to enroll than we have space, priority will be given to the older students.

ENROLLMENT FEE:

- A fee of \$300 will be charged for enrollment. This fee covers a Kansas Driver Education Permit (DE-99 Certificate of Completion) and all other instructional costs. **Deadline: Thursday, May 27th.** (See Enrollment information)
- No refund will be given.

ATTENDANCE:

- It is expected that summer plans, jobs, and vacation have been determined before the finalization of enrollment.
- Students must attend each and every session.

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION:

- All students must be accompanied by their parent or guardian.
- Enrollment for Driver Education course will be held at KSD, Roberts Building, from 1:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 27th - Room #209

NOTE:

1. If a student wears prescribed eyeglasses, he/she must wear them during enrollment and driving lessons.
2. If a student already has an IP, he/she must have a permit present during enrollment.
3. If a student doesn't have an IP, it is required to get one before enrollment.
